

BY-LAW NO. 53/94

Being a by-law of the County of Mountain View No. 17 in the province of Alberta to change the designation of Scentless Chamomile pursuant to the Weed Control Act R.S.A. 1980

WHEREAS Scentless Chamomile is designated as a Noxious Weed in Alberta Regulation 138/80 of the Weed Control Act, R.S.A. 1980, and

WHEREAS Scentless Chamomile is a prolific re-seeder and has been found in a few locations throughout the County of Mountain View, and

WHEREAS the County of Mountain View desires to control the spread of Scentless Chamomile in the County, and

WHEREAS the Weed Control Act, R.S.A. 1980, Section 7(1), authorizes a local authority to make a by-law designating plants within the municipality as restricted


THEREFORE the Council of the County of Mountain View No. 17 hereby enacts as follows:

That Scentless Chamomile be designated as a restricted weed within the County of Mountain View as per section 7(1) of the Weed Control Act of Alberta, R.S.A. 1980.




