## Sundre annexation of Mountain View County land approved

*Bylaw enforcement, road maintenance, permits, applications on subject lands now Sundre responsibility*

An Order in Council was issued on July 15, 2010 providing for the annexation of land by the Town of Sundre. Order in Council 224/2010 stipulates that under the Municipal Government Act (sections 125 and 138) approximately 495 hectares (1223 acres) of land be separated from Mountain View County and annexed to the Town of Sundre, effective January 1, 2010.

Therefore all municipal activities within the annexed lands—such as bylaw enforcement, road maintenance, permits and applications—are to immediately become the responsibility of the Town of Sundre.

According to Section 18(2) of the Municipal Government Act, any roads on the south and west boundaries with Mountain View County will remain the responsibility of the County, while roads on all other boundaries and internal roads are the responsibility of the Town of Sundre, except where otherwise stated in the order.

## Five-generations of farming excellence recognized

*Casebeer family of Carstairs receive the 2010 BMO Farm Family Award for Mountain View County*

Congratulations to the Mernus Casebeer family, the recipients of the 2010 BMO Farm Family Award for Mountain View County.

The Casebeers, who homesteaded east of Carstairs in 1901, have been recognized at the 2010 Calgary Exhibition and Stampede for five generations of farming excellence, and for combining the ideals and traditions of the past with up-to-date business and technological practices.

Every year the Mountain View County Agriculture Service Board selects a nominee family from one of the seven County electoral divisions, based on the difference they have made to the farming community in their area. Jeff Holmes, Agricultural Fieldman for Mountain View County, says the Casebeer family is a worthy recipient of the 2010 award.

“Their commitment to agriculture and to their community makes the Casebeers fitting ambassadors for Mountain View County,” Holmes added.

Local County Councillor Gwen Day says the Casebeers are dedicated farmers, and through their involvement in the Ag Society, local sports, the curling club and 4H, exemplify what it takes to be true community members.

“Carstairs and area would not be the same without the contribution of this family in so many ways,” said Day. “Their strong family ties shone through during the proud moment when all 15 of the family members took the stage together to receive the award at the Stampede Grounds on July 12. It’s a real joy to honor this deserving family,”

The Casebeer Family will be invited to County Council following the Stampede celebrations to receive a plaque commemorating the family’s selection as the recipient of the 2010 BMO Farm Family Award.
