## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO OPERATE WATER VALLEY CAMPGROUND

### Background

Mountain View County is currently accepting proposals for Operation of the Water Valley Campground. The Campground operates annually from May 15 thru October 31. The Campground is located north of Water Valley along the Little Red Deer River at SW2-30-5-W5 and has 50 sites.

### Scope of Requirements

The successful operator will be required to maintain camping facilities, collect revenue and report occupancy rates to Mountain View County on a monthly basis. Supply of miscellaneous items such as garbage bags and toilet paper will be the responsibility of the operator. Contract length is for 1 year.

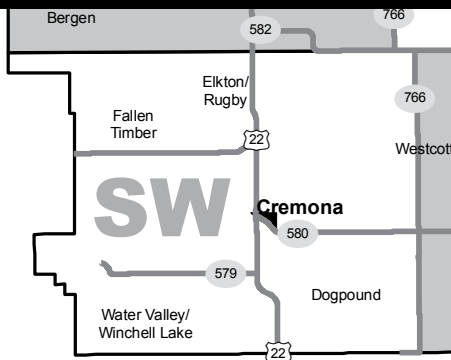

## Road Watch ----- April 2011

### Southwest Quadrant

1. Road Maintenance - surface grading (where required)
2. Sign Maintenance
3. Patching (cold mix)
4. Site line brushing / burning
5. Snow plowing / sanding (when required)
6. Culvert Steaming
7. Flood patrolling

## Riparian Area Management Improvements Funding Available

Mountain View County has funding available for riparian area projects within the County. Eligible projects include riparian fencing, off-site watering systems, and creek crossings. Mandatory improvements as a condition of subdivisions on both Environmental Reserve Easements and Restricted Covenants, and voluntary projects on agriculturally zoned land may also apply for funding. Only the cost of materials is eligible for funding.

**The deadline for applications is April 29, 2011.**
