

9. SNOWPLOWING

Policy Statement:

Mountain View County may approve the snowplowing of private driveways, feed stacks, granaries, etc.

Regulations:

1. Requests for snowplowing will be made to the Public Works Department.
2. The rates charged will be according to the fee schedule approved annually by County Council.
3. There will be a minimum 1/2 hour charge any time a County employee leaves a main road to complete a special project.
4. Details of the work done are to be noted on the time cards of the employees providing the service.
5. No off highway work will be performed until all roads in the division have been cleared of snow, bona fide emergencies excepted.
6. Charges for snowplowing may be written off with approval of County Council at a regularly scheduled council meeting.

Write-off procedures:

1. A formal request, in writing, must be made to County Council to have snow removal charges written off.
2. The request must identify reasons why this charge should be written off.
3. Reasons for waiving snow removal charges are to be determined by County Council but may include financial need and emergency medical situations.
